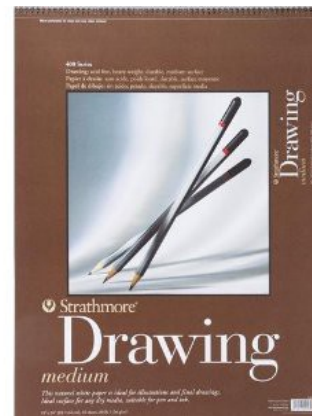


# Drawing Materials

1. Drawing paper pad. No smaller than 11x14in.



2. If you like to use pencils, get these common drawing pencils (HB, B, 2B, 4B, 6B, 8B)



OR if you like charcoal drawings more, please feel free to get these charcoal pencils (HB, B, 2B, 4B, 6B)

And also add a box of vine charcoal as well.



3. knife for sharpening pencils.



4. Sand paper block or just normal sand paper for sharpening pencils and charcoal pencils.



5. 2 or more kneaded erasers.



6. Hard erasers (common erasers)
7. Eraser pencils (for little details)



8. Fixative spray for pencil or charcoal drawings (or a bottle of steel can hair spray works too, but hair sprays might or might not yellow later)
